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KCH Origins

- Original County Hospital was built in 1961 replacing the George R. Aiken Hospital.
 - The original hospital was built with Hill-Burton Funds
 - Currently – Cowboy Bunkhouse
- Kane County Human Resource SSD – Formed September 1989
 - KCH is a Special Service District of Kane County
 - No private ownership
 - Established to serve the residents and visitors of Kane County
- September 8, 1997 – New Hospital construction completed
 - Built with a bond supported by 1% Sales Tax Revenue
 - 1% Sales Tax began in October of 1993
- September 13, 1997 – Ribbon cutting



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KCH Services

- KCH is a 25 bed Critical Access Hospital (CAH)
 - 10 Inpatient Beds
 - 15 Long-term Beds
- Services Provided

- Expand Surgical Services

- Add Echo studies and Dexa Scan to the imaging department



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House to Medical Offices

- We have developed plans for the house on 300 North to convert it to a Medical Office.
 - IV Therapy and Chemotherapy
 - Behavioral Health Counseling Center
 - Senior Life 55 and up Counseling Center







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Future Outpatient Services Building

- Future 3 story building to provide new services to include;
 - Ambulatory same day surgery
 - Physical therapy
 - Dialysis
 - IV Therapy and Chemotherapy (Expansion Plan)
 - Sleep Studies (Possibly here or in hospital)
 - Office Spaces
 - Roof top Conference Center
- Timeline 3 years







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Renovate Hospital Space

- After completion of the outpatient center, we will move services within the hospital and add additional services.
 - Move Lab
 - Move Physical Therapy to new outpatient center
 - Move current Business Office
 - Expand cafeteria to allow public access
 - Expand Imaging and add services
 - Add Dexa Scan
 - Add Mammography – New inhouse location
 - Add MRI – New inhouse location
- Timeline 18 months to build (5 years out)

Some of the surgical services that Dr. Hewitt provides are arthroscopic & minimally invasive procedures, shoulder & knee procedures, rotator cuff repair, anterior cruciate ligament (ACL) reconstruction, and complex revision procedures.





Dr. Robert C. Ripley is board certified and member of The American College of Surgeons, in the specialty of general surgery. General surgery is a broad specialty that includes diseases of the intestinal tract, trauma, endocrine, skin, muscle, and blood vessels. Common surgeries and procedures include colonoscopy, esophagogastroduodenoscopy (EGD), hernia repair, gallbladder removal, appendectomies, and surgery for cancers of the colon and breast. In addition to surgeries, general surgeons also do office procedures to remove skin cancers, cysts, skin tags, external hemorrhoids, and small tumors (lumps underneath the skin).

Dr. Ripley completed his medical training at The Medical College of Virginia and his internship and residency at The Medical College of Georgia. Dr. Ripley possesses a deep understanding of the human body and its complex systems. He has honed his surgical expertise through years of hands-on experience a relentless pursuit of knowledge in the ever-evolving field of general surgery.
